Open Space improvement project update

You will be aware that we have been looking to improve the green spaces in Fratton so that they can be best used by everyone.

We engaged Davies White, an award winning firm of landscape architects, who consulted with local people about improving Kingston Rec and St Mary's Churchyard at events such as the May Fayre and the Big Lunch picnic. They also visited local schools and organisations like Central Point.

They have created a model showing the proposed improvements to Kingston Rec and a board showing proposals for St Mary's Churchyard. These can be seen at the Carnegie Library in Fratton Road from now until Tuesday afternoon. The model and board will then be on display at Fratton Community Centre until 6th September, and you can also see them at the Fratton Family Festival on 20th September.

If the community likes these proposals then we and our partners will seek funding to make the plans a reality.
